

Attention League Coordinators:

We received a very positive note from the NKY Health Department this week. Although they still highly recommend walking during golf play, they have given me acknowledgement that we can allow single rider carts IF we can do it safely and sanitize properly. I feel obligated to send all leagues a note to help us keep you safe while allowing more participation from your group during this pandemic. Please see bullet points below:

- I strongly encourage walking if you can
- We will only allow one rider per cart – even if you live in the same household. Two per cart will not be an option
- We need you to pay in advance. We must limit people in the clubhouse. You have several options to prepay. The best is to call the morning of your round and pay over the phone. We can also set you up with an account that we can draw from if you want to put a dollar amount up front to limit the need to call. We can also have the whole league prepay in advance if you can collect from the group. Again, we need prepayment as much as possible.
- I will have a dedicated person to answer phone calls and take payment so that this will not be a hassle.
- The rule will be park your car, check in outside, play and have a great time, then exit the property. Park, play, exit. We cannot have people congregating in the parking lot at trunks or truck beds.

We want to be open with carts today, tomorrow and next week. We can only do that if you help us keep you safe and follow the advice of the leaders in health and safety. Please contact me directly on my cell if you have any questions or need to walk through details for your league. I appreciate your cooperation in making KC the perfect place to enjoy a safe recreation experience during the Covid 19 pandemic. I cannot wait until we can get back to normal and celebrate the 2020 golf season. Thank you,
